

Journées de Rencontres Jeunes Chercheur·se·s 2024

Novembre 22th to 30th 2024 at Abbaye de Saint-Jacut-de-la-mer - France

The "Field and Particles" & "Nuclear" divisions of the French Physics Society (SFP) jointly organize the Journées de Rencontres Jeunes Chercheur·se·s (JRJC) 2024 conference, to be held at the **Abbaye de Saint-Jacut-de-la-mer in the department of Côtes d'Armor (Bretagne, France), from Novembre 24th to 30th, 2024**.

The 2024 edition is supported by the CNRS-IN2P3, the CEA-IRFU, the FRIF (Fédération de Recherche Interactions Fondamentales) and the research laboratory IJCLab, Subatech, LAPP, CPPM, LP-Clermont and LPSC.

This conference aims at gathering young researchers who are in their second or third year of PhD, although first year PhD students as well as young post-doc researchers are also welcome to participate. The JRJC are a very good opportunity for the participants to share their research work and get an overview of the latest research developments achieved in his/her field, within a nice and laid-back environment. A proceeding summarizing the work presented will be asked in the following of this conference week, and published in a proceeding book of the event on HAL (link to the proceedings of the 2023 edition: https://hal.science/hal-04609124).

Research topics covered by the JRJC 2024 conference are the following: astroparticle physics, nuclear astrophysics, physics beyond standard model, cosmology, theoretical physics, nuclear energy, instrumentation, medical physics, electroweak standard model, neutrinos, hadronic physics, flavor physics, nuclear structure. JRJCs are open to all young researchers, both experimenters and theoreticians!

Presentations can be given either in English or French. The conference social program foresees a half-day trip in the nearby area, as well as a public seminar.

In case you are a PhD student and you wish your participation to the JRJC to be formally recognized as a part of your training modules, do not hesitate to contact your PhD school, and keep us informed in case of difficulties.
